



2010 Region 12 Arabian Youth Jamboree

Here we are again asking for your help in defraying the cost of Region 12's most important youth activity, the Region 12 Youth Jamboree. June 15-19 at Clemson, SC will be the site of the **22nd Region 12 Arabian Youth Jamboree**. Youth from the 7 states of Region 12 will have the experience of their lives. The five days consists of clinics, seminars, contests, fun activities and horse show.

Three days of free clinics are given by trainers and instructors from within Region 12 who donate their time to the youth. Clinics are given in all disciplines of horsemanship like Halter, Showmanship, Dressage, Hunter Over Fences, Western Pleasure, Hunter Pleasure, Trail, English/Country Pleasure, and Equitation. Sport Horse Under Saddle and In Hand are also given.

Specialists hold the seminars on subjects such as "How to Fill Out an Entry Form", "How to Braid a Mane", "Question and Answer With a Steward and Judges", "What Is Dressage", "How to Set Up a Dressage Ring", and "How to Set Up a Trail Course", "Distance Riding".

Contests are varied. They are Art, Essay, Poster, Horse Knowledge, etc. Fun classes held during the week are Stick Horse Races and other fun classes. The costume classes are always exciting. Youth start planning their costumes a year in advance.

It all culminates with a Class "C" qualifying show recognized by the Arabian Horse Association and the United States Equestrian Federation and held on Friday and Saturday. Also on Friday is an Open Show for clinic youth not entering the Class "C" Show.
